## Tournament conditions

1. By “participant” we mean everyone playing at least one round at the BrainGames 2020, regardless of age, gender, nationality or club.
2. By registering for the tournament, the participant declares his/her consent to the usage of the tournament data for FIDE ELO calculation by relevant authorities. The participant also grants permission for the publication of his/her games, photos, tournament data, press reports etc.
3. In case of game or result manipulation by forbidden means, the participant declares his/her consent to be subjected to the legislation of the German Chess Federation (Deutscher Schachbund, DSB) according to the DSB statutes.
4. The participant acknowledges that the DSB statutes can be requested from the Tournament Director.
5. The participant ensures that he/she stays at a German residence for least 180 days yearly. If this is not the case, please report to the Tournament Director.
6. Smoking is strictly forbidden inside the tournament hall. There is a smokers’ area outside the building.
7. Mobile phones and other electronic devices have to be switched off inside the tournament hall. Please inform the Tournament Director about exceptions. Sounds and noises coming from an electronic device during the game leads to the loss of the game. Also, the usage of electronic devices during the game without granted permission leads to the loss of the game and an instant expulsion of the participant.
8. The organizer’s liability is excluded in case of accidents or lost objects.
9. On the next page you will find our data protection regulations, which need to be signed by every player at the venue. We’re asking under-aged participants (born after Mar 1<sup>st</sup> 2004) to hold a hardcopy of the data protection regulations, signed by the primary carer(s), at the venue.

## Prize conditions

1. The case of multiple prizes for a single player is excluded except for the case described in paragraph. 2. In case a player is qualified for multiple prizes, he/she receives the prize with the highest value. In case there are multiple prizes with the same value, following priority is applied:  
Rank > Rating > Youth / Senior > Female
2. A player can win multiple prizes only if winning one individual prize and partly one team prize simultaneously.
3. A player can not be part of multiple teams. In case of ambiguity, the player is assigned to the highest ranked team.
4. Pairings and prizes are based on German DWZ Ratings as of Feb 29<sup>th</sup> 2020 and, in case of missing DWZ ratings, on FIDE ELO ratings as of Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 2020.
5. Players with neither a rating nor an official (e.g. federation-signed) document which testifies their strength of play are excluded from any rating prizes, but still can run for ranking, age or gender prizes.

## Declaration of consent - GDPR
